Thank you for your letter of the 11th June.

I have now had an opportunity of consulting our technical expert on your query, in whose opinion the Daimler you mention is of 1909 manufacture, 22 h.p. It is just possible that it may be late 1908, but this is considered to be unlikely.

As to value, it is very difficult to put any particular price on these veteran cars as they vary enormously according to condition, popularity of make, cost of running, etc. and many other factors, and unless a particular car is known to us in detail, we never attempt to advise on price.
